



Volunteer at Tour of Lake Ellyn Bike Race on July 17

Looking for a fun activity this July? Volunteer at the Ray Whalen Builders Tour of Lake Ellyn (TOLE), part of the Intelligentsia Cup Cycling Series, on Saturday, July 17. Volunteer shifts are approximately two hours long and are scheduled throughout the day from 9 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. The assignment is simple traffic control and bike racing knowledge is not required, but you must be at least 18 years of age. Proceeds benefit the Glen Ellyn Food Pantry.

Originally conceived in the late 1970s by local cycling legend John Vande Velde, the Glen Ellyn race was resurrected in 2016. The event marks the second leg of nine locations throughout the Chicagoland area for the 2021 Intelligentsia Cup, the *largest* road racing series in the US. See more than 100 participants up close in fast-paced cycling action around the beautiful Lake Ellyn course. The challenging venue has multiple unique features including a round-about, multiple climbs, a thrilling hairpin, and a tight final turn to the finish line on Lenox.
